

POINTS FOR DISCUSSION

A. Long pending Vigilance cases:

A considerable number of vigilance cases of Inspectors are pending for years together due to the indifferent attitude of other agencies. We once again wish to record our appeal to complete the disciplinary proceedings in a time bound manner, as prescribed by CVC. Our Association has already taken up the matter with the Board and CBEC has set up one committee for studying these problems incidentally the Chairperson of the Committee happens to be the Member (P&V) of CBEC. We request the chair to provide inputs to the committee keeping in mind the sufferings of the incumbent and the ways to find out early disposal of the cases.

B. Compassionate appointment:

In spite of huge pendency of applications for compassionate appointment, it has been observed that no fresh appointment on that ground has been done recently, it is requested that immediate action in this respect is initiated.

C. Transfer Posting Norms:

Consequent upon the reorganization of the Department, a new transfer posting norms for the Inspectors of this Zone is needed to be issued immediately.

D. MACP:

It is submitted that a good number of Inspectors have not been considered for MACP and their representations in this regard are pending with the Cadre Control Authority of Inspectors of Kolkata

Zone. Cadre Control Authority of Inspectors of Kolkata Zone is humbly requested through the chair to grant MACP immediately or provide the Association reasons for not granting the MACP .

E. Accommodation:

In the changed scenario after reorganisation of the department the accommodation problems looms large at the functioning and efficiency of the department. At one hand we are suffering from the acute shortage of space on the other hand the problem is aggravated due to improper allocation of the available space. The sitting arrangement of the Inspector in the three Service Tax Commissionerates, Central Excise Audit-I Commissionerate, Non-CCA Circles of the Central Excise Audit -II Commissionerate, Durgapur Commissionerate which are newly formed - must be allotted properly. We are sorry to mention here that despite regular pursuance of this association the longstanding accommodation problem of the Headquarters of the Haldia Commissionerate is still in the position as it was years ago and no measures have been taken up by the office side to resolve the problem. In this regard it is suggested to the Chair that the rented accommodations by the department should not be vacated until and unless new premises for office is acquired and we also request the office side to resolve the issue in time bound manner.

F. Review & Recasting of Seniority List of feeder cadre of Inspectors :

It is known that the process of reviewing/recasting the Seniority List of feeder cadre of Inspectors is on. It is humbly requested the chair to issue necessary instruction for completion of the work in a time bound manner.

G. Regularization of the Ad-hoc promotion :

In the recent past a good number of Senior Tax Assistants and Stenographers have been promoted to the Inspector grade on ad-hoc basis. It is earnestly requested to regularize them as Inspector.

H. Training:

Training in a regular interval plays an important role to upgrade and refine the efficiency of the officer which in turn benefits the cause of the Department. So, symposium related to ACES, CAAP, Accounting etc. may be organized in regular intervals in the Departmental Headquarters apart from the regular training programmes at NACEN. It is also requested to nominate the Inspectors for Induction training as per seniority.

I. Holding of meeting under OCM scheme:

Meeting under OCM scheme has not been held for a long time in the different Commissionerates under this zone. The chair is earnestly requested to issue necessary instruction for holding of meeting under OCM scheme on regular basis so that, Commissionerate specific issues can be resolved at that level only.

J. Medical Assistance:

Proper authority may be urged upon to extend "Cash less medical facility" for indoor and out-door treatment. Tie-up may be made with the renowned Hospitals / Nursing Homes in Kolkata, Howrah, Hooghly, Midnapore, Bolpur, Durgapur, Asansol and Siliguri.

We are happy to note that our repeated request of covering different areas of Kolkata was pursued by the office side and finally, this area of KUSB and some other areas are now under the extended coverage of CGHS. With all our thanks to the office side we request the chair to pursue for the setting up of one CGHS Dispensary in and around the KUSB locality so that the wide no. of Central Government Employees residing in this area can avail the benefit of CGHS.
