Sub: Recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission – Bunching of stages in the revised Pay structure under Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 – Reg.


Kind reference is invited to the OM No.- 1-6/2016-IC dated 07.09.2015 of the Department of Expenditure, Implementation Cell regarding bunching of stages in the revised Pay structure (copy enclosed).

2. In this regard, it is pertinent to mention that the pay of an Inspector promoted in 2015 having basic pay of around Rs.15,000/- and a direct recruit Inspector joined in 2015 and having basic pay of Rs.17,140/- has been fixed in the 1st Cell of level 7 as per 7th Pay Commission recommendation, i.e. Rs.44,900/-. As per the bunching rules, the Inspectors who has drawn higher pay than Inspector drawing lower pay as on 31.12.2015 in the pre-revised structure and fixed in the same cell as on 01.01.2016 should be given one additional increment for every two stages bunched and the pay of Government servant drawing higher pay in pre-revised structure be fixed at the next vertical Cell in the applicable Level. Similarly, the Basic Pay of the Inspectors fixed in other cells in the levels may also be fixed according to the above principle.

3. It is further submitted that, the above bunching rules have been implemented in various Departments including the Department of Revenue and fixed the pay of the officers in accordance with the recommendation of 7th Pay Commission based on bunching of stages.

4. In view of the above facts, it is humbly requested that, the pay of the Inspectors of Central Excise and Customs for implementation to the concerned authorities and may be re fixed as per the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission and O.M. No. 1-6/2016-IC dated 07.09.2016 of the Department of Expenditure in respect of bunching of stages under Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016.
