

Subject : Recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission-Bunching of stages in the revised Pay structure under Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 -reg.

Please refer to this Association Letter dated 11.01.2017 and 22.03.2017 on the captioned subject.

We appreciate your goodself for taking cognizance of the issue and refer it to the field formations. But even after the reference from the highest office of the Zone nothing has moved till date. While the implementation of the subject Office Memorandum is already done in some of the zones the officers of this zone are still not given with the benefit of the same. Due to such situation the officers are facing financial loss by way of lesser drawl of pay.

Your kind attention is invited to the letter C.No III(15)1/Bunching/Acct/R-II/2017/1696 dated 04.04.2017 of the Additional Commissioner of Central Excise & Service Tax, Ranchi II Commissionerate and their Office Order dated 18.04.2017 wherein the fixation of pay has been done with reference to the pay of Sri K. Durga Prasad, Inspector of Central Excise, Central Excise, Customs & Service Tax, Division -II, Vishakapatnam Commissionerate (Annexure-A).

In this regard it worth mentioning that the office of Pr. Chief Controller of Accounts, CBEC, New Delhi had vide it's letter No. E-II/2(1)/bunching/Pay Fixation/7th CPC/2016-17/607 has communicated that this exercise falls within the powers of the Head of Office and the copy of the letter was marked to the Dy. Controller of Accounts (EZ), Kolkata, also (Annexure-B).

Keeping in line the office of the Dy. Controller of Accounts, CBEC, South Zone, Chennai vide letter No. A 60026/1/Dy. CA/SZ/Coord/2016-17 dated 19.04.2017 has also clarified that the Cadre Controlling Authority has to finalize the bunching cases (Annexure-C).

Sir, there are ample documents indicating the implementation of the subject Office Memorandum and we are unable to understand the reason based on which the field formation is not taking any step to implement the Office Memorandum which is in existence since last six months.

In light of the above facts this association again requests your good self to give proper directions to the concerned authorities for earliest implementation of the OM issued by the Government of India.
