**Subject:- Seekin intervention in respect of the Boards Circular vide
F.No. A-22015/117/2016-Ad.IIIA dated 20.09.2018-Reg.**

With due respect this Association would humbly like to invite your kind attention to a burning problem affecting the Inspectors of Central Excise cadre, Kolkata Zone as well as Inspectors working under other Cadre Controlling Authorities.

Inter Commissionerate Transfer (ICT) policy is one of the rare policies made by CBEC (Now CBIC) which brings some relief to Gr-B & C employees working under the CBIC. Further this policy came into existence due to Hon'ble Delhi High Court's Judgement in WP(C) No. 1624/2010 and thereafter active persuasion of this association.

Presently, the CBIC has taken a stand to cancel the ICT applications only because of want of provisions to deal with ICT in the new Recruitment Rules 2016 of Inspector Central Excise. Your kind attention is invited towards the recent Ernakulam CAT judgment in O.A. No. 180/956/2017, 180/148/2018 & 180/164/2018 dated 08/08/2018. The judgment came subsequent to the cancellation of the order no 1/A/CCSC/04/2018 dated 19.01.2018 issued from the Principal Chief Commissioner office of Lucknow zone. The Board has not paid due respect to the afore-mentioned CAT Ernakulam Bench Order and CAT Bangalore Bench Order (OA No. 170/22/2018 dated 20.08.2018 and also several communications/representation of our association while issuing the said Circular.

In spite of making several submissions by this Association to CBIC to deal with the ICT, no visible action has yet been initiated by the Board to tackle this particular problem till date.

Recently, the Board has issued a circular vide F.No. A-22015/117/2016-Ad.IIIA dated 20.09.2018 wherein it has instructed all the CCA to consider all the Inter Commissionerate Transfer (ICT) made in Inspector cadre on or after 26.12.2016 to be treated as transfer on loan basis only. This has created a severe inconvenience to our cadre. This apathy of the Board to its own staff welfare is forcing us to take up the matter with you for your kind intervention pertaining to the incumbents of the Kolkata Zone.

Further, it is also requested that necessary actions may be initiated so that there may not be any adverse impact on the salaries of the incumbents.
