OUR RESOLUTION FOR FUTURE:

- Finalization of Seniority List:**
It is requested to publish the updated seniority list in the grade of Inspector immediately since the last seniority list was issued a long time back on 30.11.2016.
- Timely issuance of Promotion Orders:**
Promotion orders to the grade of Superintendent may be issued immediately against all regular vacancies which have been chopped up due to Retirement/Promotion/VRS/Resignation/Death.

3. **Regularisation of Ad-hoc Inspectors:**
Since 2013 to till date a total no. of 317 officers have been promoted to the grade of Inspector on Ad-hoc basis. Regularisation process was initiated with the kind approval of the then Principal Chief Commissioner on 01.11.2017 and then regularisation of DPC was fixed on 24.04.2018 and subsequently the DPC was deferred on 04.05.2018 and finally it was postponed. It is therefore requested to fix up the date of regularisation of DPC immediately.
4. **Immediate restoration of ICT:**
It is learnt that due to verbal direction from the Board presently Inter Commissionerate Transfer (ICT) has been put on hold. It is requested to restore the process of ICT at the earliest.
5. **All India Seniority List:**
Proposal for preparation of All India Seniority List in the grade of Inspector to remove the regional disparity for promotion to next higher grade.
6. **Regular DPC should be conducted as per DOPT guidelines:**
DPC for promotion to Superintendent may be conducted as per latest DOPT Model calendar and guidelines.
7. **Removal of stagnation of Inspector Cadre in Kolkata Zone:**
To remove the stagnation in Inspector Cadre in Kolkata Zone, All India Seniority List of Inspector may be proposed/ the sanction strength of the posts of superintendents may be increased.
8. **Clearing of long pending vigilance cases:**
Long pending vigilance cases may be speeded up for early disposal.
9. **Ladies Common room and crèche for nursing mothers:**
Ladies common rooms and creche may be created in all offices.
10. **Appointment on compassionate ground and on sports quota:**
Appointment under Compassionate ground to the post of Havaldar and Tax Assistant may be done on regular basis for deceased family members.
11. **Persuasive action regarding maternity benefit act.**
12. **Preparation of a sub-committee comprising of female members to address the grievances pertaining to female members.**
13. **Formation of legal cell to help Inspectors involved in Vigilance cases.**
14. **Timely disposal of medical bills:**
Adequate fund may be allocated to the Budgetary head under "Medical Expenses" keeping in view of the long pending Medical Bills in all offices.
15. **Adherence to the minutes of the meeting under OCM:**
Concerned authorities may be directed to adhere to the minutes of meeting under OCM.
16. **Formation of roster for being part of AE movement regarding female Inspectors:**
Roster system may be implemented while Anti-Evasion movement is done for female Inspectors.
17. **Betterment of infrastructure of offices as well as quarters:**
For smooth functioning of office better infrastructure in offices as well as for better accommodation in quarters may be done.
18. **Arrangement of temporary accommodation for newly joined Inspectors:**
Temporary accommodation may be arranged for the all newly joined Inspectors.
19. **Fixation of tenure of posting at Hill areas of Darjeeling & Kalimpong Districts and entire Sikkim for one Year:**
It is requested to consider the posting at Hill areas of Darjeeling & Kalimpong Districts be restricted to only one year.
20. **Attachment of recognized Private Hospitals for Medical facilities for the staff posted in North Bengal and South Bengal:**
21. **Confirmation orders in respect of Inspectors joined Kolkata Zone on ICT:**
It is requested that confirmation orders may be issued to the Inspectors whose confirmation is due even after completion of probation period.
